

CCC Ministry Position Description

Special Needs Class Volunteer for Youth/Adult 10:45am Sunday Morning Bible Class

Purpose: To co-facilitate and provide assistance, support and friendship to youth and adults with a disability in a self-contained classroom during the 10:45am service 2x/month.

Responsibilities:

- Co-teach adapted Bible curriculum to attendees.
- Prepare additional activities and collect supplies, make copies, etc., communicating with CCC staff as needed.
- Love and accept these individuals just as they are, valuing their uniqueness and reflecting God's love for them.
- Be a friend to these individuals – someone that they look forward to seeing.
- Pray regularly for these individuals and their families as God leads.
- Learn how the individuals communicate and assist with their communication with others.
- Encourage social interaction among classmates.
- Provide necessary physical assistance for mobility, seating, game playing and learning activities.
- Assist with self-help skills according to church guidelines.
- As they are provided and as you learn more about the attendees, use appropriate behavior management techniques to ensure their comfort, safety and security.

Specific Position Qualifications:

- A person who has an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ as their personal savior and a Christian walk that reflects the fruits of the Spirit.
- Someone who longs to share God's heart with an individual who might feel different or left out, or who may be unaware that his or her challenges hinder others from interacting with him or her.
- A person who is motivated, excited and enthusiastic about being with and learning from these special people.
- Someone who can display high energy, creativity and patience, and who believes individuals with special needs can love God and serve their world.
- Displays integrity, sensitivity and confidentiality, treating each person and family with respect.
- Is teachable and dependable.
- Is 16 years or older.
- Completes volunteer application and background check.

Time Commitment: Approximately 1.5 hours every other week including prep time

Length of Commitment: One year, renewable by mutual agreement

Success Measures: Successful and timely completion of above responsibilities

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
