CCC CHOIR GUIDELINES:

General Info

- Culture - As we embrace a true culture of joy, enthusiasm, and freedom, we aim to be judgement free, gossip free, and clique free zones. We will be respectful of one another, and allow leadership only to provide directives.
- Attendance - The expectation is that everyone attends all rehearsals and minister at all weekend services. There are some exceptions as arranged through Choir leadership. We ask that choir is meaningfully prioritized and planned for in your overall schedule. We need you! If you cannot attend a service or rehearsal, or will be late, please send an email to choirattendance@coloradocommunity.org. Inactive or non-communicative members will be removed from our choir list.
- Recordings of the songs and lyrics are provided ahead of time using our choir online software, Planning Center Online (PCO). Members should expect receive a PCO sign up ahead of the choir season. **Please accept or decline your PCO invitations upon receiving them.** Songs should be practiced ahead of rehearsal. PCO is also used for all choir communications/emails.
- Serving within choir - We have many people within choir that are serving in many helpful ways. Even small tasks per week help our choir remain organized and efficient. Those that are interested in serving in this way should email mpulley@coloradocommunity.org.

Thursday Night Choir Rehearsals (Designated Thursdays Only, Typically 2x per Month)

- Rehearsals are held in the Worship Center. We will start at 6:30 PM and end by 8:30 PM. Please be as prompt as possible. Early preferred. We've also set short devotions near the beginning of rehearsal as a way for us to transition from our busy daily life into a time of rehearsal and worship.

Ministry Weekends (Typically One Weekend Per Month During Choir Season)

- On Saturday, please be in the Youth Auditorium at 2:00 PM for prayer and pre-ministry rehearsal.
- On Sunday, please be in the Worship Center by 8:00 AM for prayer, review, and soundcheck.
- The Choir brunch (potluck) will be immediately following soundcheck. We can arrive as early as 7:45 AM to set up brunch items in the Youth Rec Room. Bringing food is optional, but all are encouraged to participate in eating and fellowshiping together.
- The Youth Auditorium will be available to choir members throughout all services as a "greenroom" type space, and also for storage. However, please keep valuables on your person or in your vehicle.
- Choir members are encouraged to listen to at least one sermon during the weekend service.
- Ten minutes prior to each service, we will come together to pray, and then proceed to the stage. The prayer times will be led by the Choir Leadership Team.
- We should walk onto the risers 2 mins. prior to the start of service in continued quietness and prayer for the service.
- If you miss the start of a performance, please don't walk on stage during that song, rather, wait until the next break, after the *Call to Worship* or before the *Offering*. If you miss those breaks, it means you should wait until the next service.

Be Aware of Those Around You

Since we rehearse and perform in fairly close quarters, please be aware of and respect your colleagues. Here is a quick list of specifics for when we get together:

- Please don't wear cologne or perfume. We don't all agree on what smells good, plus some fragrances can cause others to sneeze or have headaches.
- Please practice good oral hygiene and good overall hygiene.
- Avoid eating fragrant foods just before rehearsals and ministry weekend times.

Dress Code

We should always remember who we are reflecting and representing - our church, our staff, our leadership, the congregation. Most importantly, we want to honor our Lord and Savior, Jesus. We are on stage & camera, so please dress appropriately, not drawing undue attention to yourself. We do aim for freedom to dress comfortably, and expressing our own individual styles. We ask that you keep these requests in mind when you go to your closets:

- Please make an effort to be presentable. Jeans are appropriate, however, ripped jeans revealing substantial skin are not appropriate.

Dress Code (continued)

- Avoid clothing with symbols or messages (this includes sport teams clothing) that could cause distraction from our time of worship.
- Avoid wearing white, cream, or light beige as a primary color in your outfit, because it can make you “glow” under the lights.
- Avoid neon type colors that could draw undue attention.
- Please do not wear hats as they can distract or fall off.
- Please avoid tight shirts.
- Men: Please do not wear your pants in a sagging fashion.
- Ladies: Please keep skirts & dresses at a reasonable length, because there will be a considerable amount of movement.
- Ladies: Avoid super low-rise pants where you are at risk of revealing undergarments.
- Ladies: Avoid skin tight body dresses, revealing cleavage or midsections
- Ladies: Sheer clothing becomes more sheer under the lights, so layer as necessary.
- Ladies: Leggings, jeggings, and skinny jeans are acceptable, but please wear modest top with these. If someone is wearing sheer or thin leggings, then a tunic (very long dress-like blouse), dress, or long sweater that adequately covers front and back “key areas” is required. We may be jumping, etc. so several inches of length to supplement may be necessary.

Choir Leadership Team

- The Choir Leadership Team (CLT) is a group of people that serve the choir by encouraging them and praying for them, meeting practical needs, leading devotions, planning, and providing overall leadership. You will be assigned a CLT member at the start of choir season.

Choir Chaplain, Linda Evans Johnson (Elder) (720) 343-0102 (You can call her 24/7)

- Linda is available to all choir members to assist with any private spiritual, physical, financial, or personal needs, privately and confidentially. She is our church resource liaison and is also available for personal prayer or even just to talk. Linda is available to teach, mentor and educate in a non-judgmental way.

Prayer

- On rehearsal nights, the Worship Center will be available from 6:10 PM to 6:20 PM for those who would like to spend some time at the altar in worship or prayer before starting. If desired, Members of the CLT are available to pray with you during this time. Please be reverent of this space.
- Send an email to choirprayer@coloradocommunity.org if you would like the whole choir to pray for your situation. Please indicate if you would like responses sent to your email address. If your situation is more private, just specify this in your email, and only the Choir Leadership Team will be alerted for prayer.
- During our Sunday brunch, there will be opportunities to share praise reports/prayer requests.
